## Brief facts of the complaint

The complainant has filed a complaint stating that his maternal uncle lives in Sultanpuri and his two daughters namely Jaya and Neha are missing since 1.9.2017. They made a complaint at PS Sultanpuri on the same night regarding the missing of both the girls, but the police has not taken any action. The complainant has requested for necessary action in the matter.

### 3 Relevant facts emerging during the hearing

An ATR has been filed by SI Rajender Tomar, PS Sultan Puri, stating the following:-

i. It is submitted that a case FIR NO. 655/15 u/s 363 IPC dated 2.9.2017 was registered on the complaint of Shri Shambu Nayak regarding missing of his two twins daughters namely 1) Neha-16.2 years and 2) Jaya 16.2 years. He alleged that on dated 1.9.2017 at 7 p.m. his both daughters went somewhere alongwith Bank Pass Book and school documents without giving any information to him.

The investigation was entrusted to IO SI Rajender Tomar and during the course of investigation, WT message was flashed and missing information about girls was sent to NCRB, Doordarshan, and photos were published in Local Newspaper.

ii. Further, it is submitted that the girls were recovered on dated 7.9.2017. Both girls were medically examined in SGMH on 7.9.2017 and statements of both girls u/s 164 Cr.P.C. were got recorded by Hon'ble Court on 8.9.2017. However, as per that statement of both girls no offence was found occurred with them and complainant did not want any other police action into the matter as his both girls has been recovered safely. Therefore, no police action is required to be taken into the matter. Further, said case has already been cancelled. Copy of 164 Cr.P.C. statements are enclosed for perusal."
