1. Brief facts of the complaint

The complainant has filed a complaint of inaction against PS Kalkaji. She has alleged that she and her daughter were beaten, abused and harassed by some persons for which she lodged a complaint at No. 100. Subsequently, the police took her alongwith her daughter and the alleged persons to the police station and released the alleged without taking any action against them whereas she was made to wait the whole night and was not got medically examined. She made a complaint to the DCP/Sarita Vihar but no action was taken by him also. She has requested for legal action in the matter.

2. Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission

The PGC convened its first hearing in the complaint on 14th November, 2017, the second hearing held on 9th January, 2018 and the third hearing held on 27th February, 2018, when the following were present:-
