1. Brief facts of the complaint

The complainant has filed a complaint of inaction against IO Kamal Kishore for not taking any action on her complaint regarding murder of her son Javed @ Babloo by her daughter-in-law Salma and her family members. She has also alleged that the IO has not recorded her statement and got his son Rizwan and Pappu signature on blank papers and has himself written that Babloo was a habitual drinker and committed suicide in anger, which is totally false. She has alleged that the IO was connived with the culprits i.e. Chaman and Salma and was trying to protect them. He has requested for legal action in the matter.

2. **Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission**

The PGC convened its first hearing in the complaint on 28th August, 2017, the second hearing held on 6th November, 2017, the third hearing held on 15th January, 2018 and the fourth hearing held on 26th February, 2018, when the following were present:-

An ATR has been filed by ASI Kamal Kishore, PS Mayur Vihar stating that "on receipt DD No. 11A, dated 12.5.2017 regarding a quarrel, he reached at the site and found body of Javed @ babloo aged 30 years lying on the floor near

the stairs at first floor, as chunni was tied to his neck. On enquiry, it was known that the other end of the chunni was tied to window of the grill which was at a height of 9-9.5 feet from the floor. The body was taken off by one tenant residing in the same building at 3rd Floor namely Nahar Singh s/o late Shri Ram Prakash Kashyap by tearing of the chunni. There was no movement in the body and he had died. SHO as well as Crime Team was also called at the site. In the postmortem report the doctor has opined it to be a case of hanging. From all these facts/circumstances it is clear that Babloo has committed suicide by hanging himself. He has not been killed by anyone, enquiries in this regard were also made from the neighbourhood. The allegations leveled by mother of the deceased are false. "
