1. Brief facts of the complaint

The complainant has filed a complaint of illegal extortion of money against ASI Harbeer Singh and other police personnel. He has alleged that while he alongwith his colleagues were waiting nearby Anand Vihar ISBT police booth on 3rd November, 2017 at 11.30 p.m. , they observed that the alleged police personnel were extorting money from the vehicles entering Delhi from UP. He has further alleged that the police personnel got aggravated due to their presence there and asked them rudely to leave that place. He also threatened them to shoot. He has requested for legal action in the matter.

2. Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission

The PGC convened its first hearing in the complaint on 29th January, 2018 and the second hearing held on 12th March, 2018, when the following were present:-

3 Relevant facts emerging during the hearing

An ATR has been filed by ACP Rishi Dev, for DCP/East District through ASI Raj Kumar, 19/East, stating that “ as per the direction of PGC, a secret watch at the place of occurrence was kept by the staff of PG Cell on 8.2.2018 , 9.2.2018 5.3.2018 but no police personnel had taken/demanded of money from the vehicles entering Delhi from UP. In this regard, the statements of duty staff of MCD toll tax namely Vijay Uttam Nande, Magender, Shyam Singh and Rehri-patri walas were recorded who deposed that no police personnel had

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taken/demanded money from any one. The allegations could not be substantiated during enquiry. Hence, the present complaint may be filed.”

The complainant has not attended any of the two hearings held in the Commission so far. It appears that he is not interested in pursuing his case in PGC.

4. Directions of PGC

In view of the above, the Commission has decided to close the case in PGC.
