## **1. Brief facts of the complaint**

The complainant has filed a complaint stating that his plots in Burari area 524/144 and 524/145 have been sold by preparing forged paper by one Shri Hemant Gupta , r/o Civil Lines to Shri Kapil Gaur for which he had filed complaints with the area SHO and DCP as well. He has alleged that Hemant Gupta is involved in many such activities and the police is also connived with him. On complaining to the police, instead of taking action against the alleged, the police is favouring the alleged and convincing the complainant that the alleged person is quite influential. He has further stated that the two plots were allotted to them by the government. He has requested for legal action in the matter.

The PGC convened its first hearing in the complaint on 13<sup>th</sup> Oct., 2016, the second hearing on 15<sup>th</sup> December, 2016, the third hearing held on 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 2017, the fourth hearing held on 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2017, the fifth hearing held on 3<sup>rd</sup> August, 2017, the sixth hearing held on 9<sup>th</sup> November, 2017, the seventh hearing held on 11<sup>th</sup> January, 2018, the eighth hearing held on 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2018, ninth hearing held on 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2018 and the tenth hearing held on 22<sup>nd</sup> March, 2018, when the following were present:-

## **3 Relevant facts emerging during the hearing**

On the last date of hearing, the complainant was not present and he was again directed “to appear before the Commission in person in today’s hearing, failing which, his case will be closed in the Commission”.
