1. Brief facts of the complaint

The complainant has filed a complaint alleging that police is putting undue pressure on her to deposit original papers of her jhuggi with the police. She stated that police will destroy the evidence if she deposits these papers. She also stated apprehension of threat from the Chowki Incharge, who may misuse his power. The complainant has requested for necessary action in the matter.

2. Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission

The PGC convened its first hearing in the complaint on 23rd November, 2017 , the second hearing held on 1st February, 2018, the third hearing held on 22nd February, 2018 and the fourth hearing held on 22nd March, 2018, when the following were present:-

3 Relevant facts emerging during the hearing

An ATR has been filed by SI Kali Charan, PS Ashok Vihar stating that “ he came to know from the neighbours that the jhuggi No. N 20/418 belongs to Vijay Singh. Vijay Singh is living in the jhuggi at present.The electricity connection was installed on 18.1.2018 and application for installing electricity was given on 13.12.2017. The bill is in the name of Babu Lal. There is no water meter. The matter is running in the court. Shri Vijay Singh is living in the jhuggi and jhuggi on the upper floor is vacant. Prior to

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19.1.2018, Vijay Singh was using electricity by putting direct wire. From 19.1.2018, the electric meter is in the name of Babu Lal.”

4. Directions of PGC

The complainant is present and informed the Commission that she has filed the instant case in the court.

As per mandate of the Commission, any matter which is sub judice in nature cannot be taken up by the Commission for hearing. The Commission has, therefore, decided to close the case being sub judice, with the advice to the complainant to pursue the case in the Court of law.
