1. Brief facts of the complaint

The complainant has filed a complaint stating that his Investigating Officer Om Prakash, PS Kanjhawala is not doing proper investigation in his case FIR NO. 0225, dated 5.6.2016. He has requested for updating the status on his complaint. He has requested for necessary action into the matter.

2. Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission

The PGC convened its first hearing in the complaint on 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2017, the second hearing held on 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2018, the third hearing held on 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2018 and the fourth hearing held on 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2018, when the following were present:-

3. Relevant facts emerging during the hearing

An ATR has been filed by IO ASI Anil Kumar, PS Kanjhawala stating that “papers handed over to Kamal Kumar were found to be forged on scrutiny on which property dealer Vijay Singh was formally arrested on 20.3.2018 from Tihar Jail, who is undergoing JC since 22.3.2018. The witness Santosh Kumar has obtained anticipatory bail on 3.4.2018; however, he has not joined investigation. Soon the case will be put in the Court. Whereabouts of the plot owner Vikas Kumar are not known.”

4. Directions of PGC

IO is present and stated that the remaining accused Santosh Kumar has been granted anticipatory bail by the court and he will be interrogated soon with regard to investigation in the

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case.

Police is directed to conclude the investigation at the earliest and file a chargesheet in the court of law against the alleged persons as per the outcome of the investigation.

With the above advice, the Commission has decided to close the case in PGC.
