1. Background :

Sh. Raj Kapoor, the appellant vide DRTI application dated 08.02.2017 has sought information on total 3 counts.

The appellant did not receive any information from the Competent Authority i.e. District Magistrate (North West), Revenue Department. Hence, he filed an appeal before the Public Grievances Commission.

2. Proceedings

The applicant is present and heard.

Shri Vinod Kumar, UDC, present on behalf of the Competent Authority or Department, submits a letter, giving point-wise information to the queries of the appellant. The information has been perused and is found to be satisfactory.

The appellant, however, expresses his dis-satisfaction with the information provided. According to him, the borewell is still functioning at the spot.

3. Decision

Since the information provided is satisfactory, the appeal case is closed.

However, the District Magistrate (North West), Revenue Department, is advised to get the site inspected and verify, if the borewell is still functioning or not. An ATR may be submitted to this Commission for perusal.
