1 Brief facts of the complaint

The complainant has filed a complaint of non-registration of FIR on his complaint of defrauding/cheating him of Rs. 1.6 lakhs withdrawing from his SBI account. He has stated that on 6.6.2018, 1.6 lakhs was withdrawn from his ATM from Jaipur whereas he was at Delhi and he did not share any details regarding the ATM. The defrauding amount was transferred to the account of one Anil Kumar. He has further stated that in spite of visiting the police station, his FIR has not been lodged. He has requested for legal action in the matter.

2. Facts emerging during the proceedings

SHO/S. Avenue Vijay Pal Dahiya is present and stated that on the complaint of the complainant, a case has been registered and the case is under investigation.

The complainant is present. He stated that police registered an FIR in the matter after the lapse of 48 days but no legal action has been taken against the alleged Anil Kumar in whose account Rs. 80,000/- has been transferred. He has filed a representation in this regard.

3. Directions of PGC

A copy of the representation filed by the complainant is being sent to SHO/S. Avenue to look into it and take legal action as per law. He is also directed to keep the complainant informed about the progress of the case every fortnight.

With the above advice, the Commission has decided to close the case in PGC.
