1. Brief facts of the complaint

The complainant has filed a complaint of serious misconduct of police officials of PS Maurice Nagar. He has stated that he went to the police station alongwith his senior Advocate to register a complaint. He has alleged that at the instructions of SI Praveen Narwal, he was beaten in the police station by 3-4 police Constables. He has further stated that the alleged SI got him thrashed as he had filed many complaints against him. The complainant has requested for legal action in the matter

2 Facts emerging during the proceedings

An ATR has been filed by Inspector Arvind Kumar, PG Cell/North District, stating the following :-

“An enquiry was conducted by PG Cell/North to verify the facts and allegations. In this regard, a report was submitted by PG Cell to the senior officers. There were some queries from senior officers and the report was sent back to the PG Cell.

To clarify few facts, complainant was called but he refused to come to PG Cell. He was requested to suggest an alternate place where he is available. He however insisted to meet him at his Advocate's Chamber at Tis Hazari Courts Complex or to come in the office of MLA. He was requested to suggest nearby public place in and around PS Maurice Nagar jurisdiction but till date he has not informed or joined the enquiry.”

The complainant is present. When asking to sign the declaration regarding his grievance not pending in any judicial court, he refused to sign the declaration and informed the Commission that he has already filed a case in this regard in the Hon'ble Delhi High Court.
