## 1. Background:

Sh. Subhash Chand, the appellant vide his application dated 13.09.2017 under Delhi Right to Information Act, 2001, had sought information from the Deputy Commissioner (Civil Lines Zone), North DMC, Competent Authority notified under the DRTI Act-2001 on total 5 queries.

The appellant did not receive any information from the Competent Authority i.e. Deputy Commissioner (Civil Lines Zone) of North DMC. Hence, he filed the appeal before the Appellate Authority, Public Grievances Commission.

### 2. Proceedings:

The appellant is not present.

Shri A.V. Sharma, A.E. (B), CLZ, appeared on behalf of the department submitted a copy of the reply dated 05.06.2018, furnished to the appellant with reference to his application dated 13.09.2017.

#### 3. **Decision:**

The appellant is seeking information regarding unauthorized construction in Kh. No. 101 (4-16), Near Swastik Public School, Village Ibrahimpur, Delhi.

In the hearing on 07.06.2018, the department representative submitted that reply has already been furnished to the appellant on 05.06.2018. The reply was examined.

On perusal of replies, it has been revealed that the Competent Authority has provided satisfactory information in respect of all the queries of the appellant, hence no further action is required in the matter.

The Commission notes that there is inordinate delay in furnishing the information / reply to the appellant. The Competent Authority i.e. Deputy Commissioner (Civil Lines Zone), North DMC is directed to be careful and ensure that the replies are furnished to the

appellant within 30 days from the date of receipt of the application, as stipulated under Delhi Right to Information Act-2001.

The matter is accordingly closed at the Commission's end.
