1. Brief facts of the complaint

The complainant has filed a complaint stating that Ladi keeps bad eye on the female/women of the locality. He is also involved in anti-social activities like running of satta , sex racket etc. She also alleged that police is aware about it, but police has not taken any action. The complainant has requested for legal action in the matter.

2. Proceedings in the Public Grievances Commission

3 Relevant facts emerging during the hearing

Neither an ATR has been filed nor any representative from Delhi Police is present. The Commission has taken a serious view for non-presence of the concerned representative.

On the last date of hearing, the complainant was not present, therefore, a copy of the ATR filed by Delhi Police was sent to the complainant for her information and furnishing her comments, if any, in today's hearing. The complainant is neither present nor has furnished/sent her comments. It appears that she is not interested in pursuing her case in PGC.
